- 17:00: special lock opening upstream
- anchoring in **Camoël**, upstream after the barrage

Wednesday 28 th: *From a bank to the other*

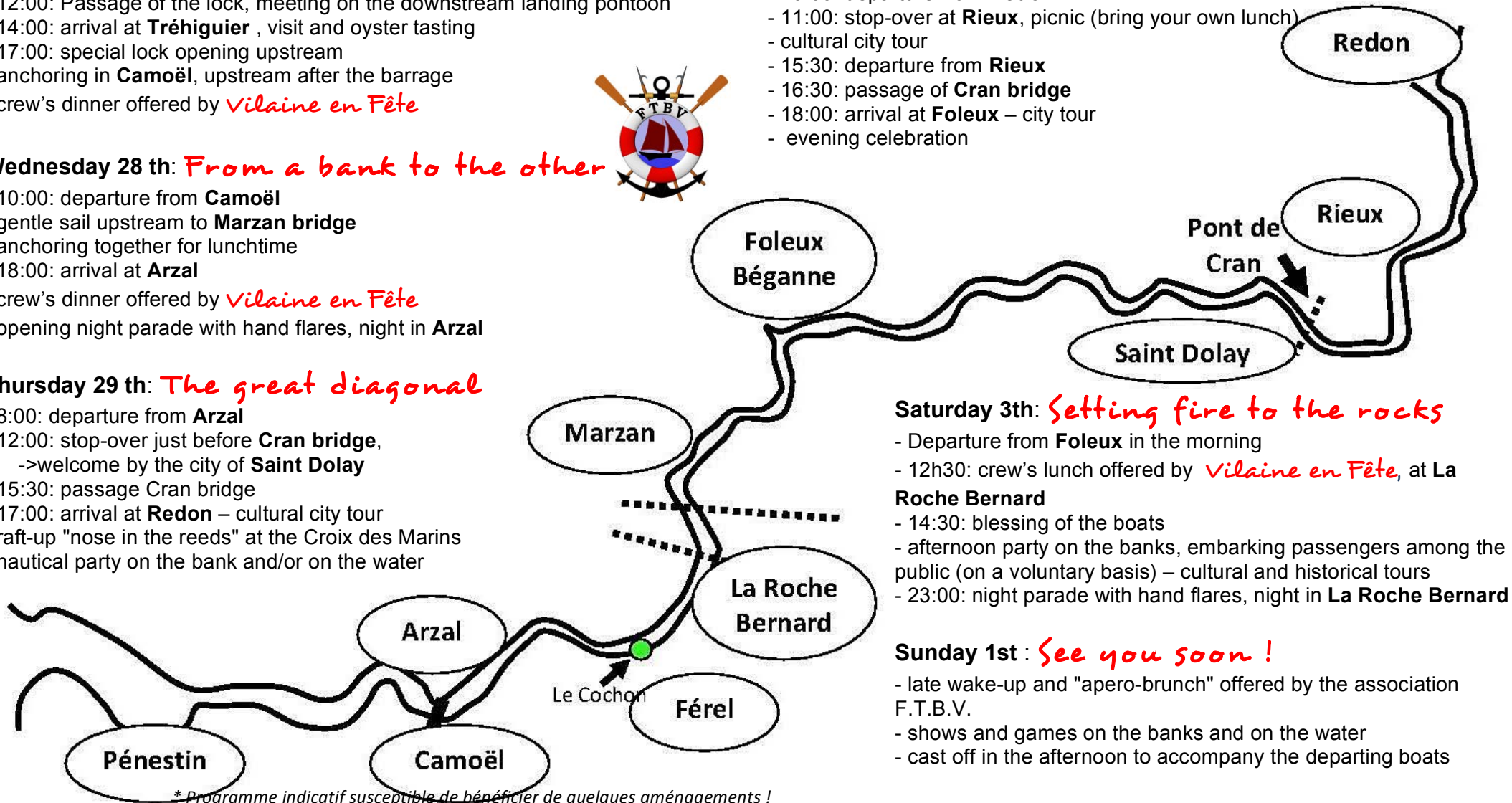
- 10:00: departure from **Camoël**
- gentle sail upstream to **Marzan bridge**
- anchoring together for lunchtime
- 18:00: arrival at **Arzal**

- opening night parade with hand flares, night in **Arzal**

Thursday 29 th: *The great diagonal*

- 8:00: departure from **Arzal**
- 12:00: stop-over just before **Cran bridge**,
->welcome by the city of **Saint Dolay**
- 15:30: passage Cran bridge
- 17:00: arrival at **Redon** – cultural city tour
- raft-up "nose in the reeds" at the Croix des Marins
- nautical party on the bank and/or on the water

Friday 30 th: *Rieux, Foleux : a rural break*

- 10:00: departure from **Redon**
- 11:00: stop-over at **Rieux**, picnic (bring your own lunch)
- cultural city tour
- 15:30: departure from **Rieux**
- 16:30: passage of **Cran bridge**
- 18:00: arrival at **Foleux** – city tour
- evening celebration



Saturday 3th: *Setting fire to the rocks*

- Departure from **Foleux** in the morning
- 12h30: crew's lunch offered by *Vilaine en Fête*, at **La Roche Bernard**
- 14:30: blessing of the boats
- afternoon party on the banks, embarking passengers among the public (on a voluntary basis) – cultural and historical tours
- 23:00: night parade with hand flares, night in **La Roche Bernard**
