OGA Awards and trophies

Sue Farrer, OGA Trophy Secretary, presented awards and trophies for the 2013 sailing season at the AGM on 11 January 2014. Many recipients were awarded trophies in recognition of achievements during the Round Britain Challenge (RBC).

A full report on the awards and trophies will be published in the March 2014 edition of Gaffers Log.

Jolyan Lumai is currently in the Caribbean, working in his first job as a professional crew member, now aged just 20. His nomination came from Eric Stoneham, for sailing as crew-member on RBC vessel 'Minstrel' from Caernarfon to Cowes.

Dan Shaw, pictured below receiving his trophy from Sue, insisted on accepting the award alongside the Solent Jubilee Committee and Pete Thomas representing the East Coast.

Barbara Runnalls was presented with the Gaffers Globe at the Boat Show by Tom Cunliffe. She wins the award for her single-handed RBC circumnavigation in 'Moon River'.

Aimee and Alice Erb accepted the Grumpy II Cups on behalf of the family who sail 'Aurora' at events around the UK.

Andrew Wolstenholme, nominated by Moray MacPhail for his latest creation 'Kite', is the first recipient of the new Jolie Brise Trophy, awarded for 'significant contribution to the development of gaff rig'.

Roy Hart accepted his trophy for trailering and sailing 'Greensleeves', a 19' Memory, for significant parts of the RBC including four crossings of the Irish Sea single-handed.
